




So you need to add a modifier in medent.

What's next?

A modifier provides the means by which the reporting physician can indicate that a service or CPT/HCPCS that has been performed has been altered by some specific circumstances but not changed in its definition or code.



Please see the medent Manual for examples of when modifiers are used.



Navigation Steps

- Under Practice Management, click **Setup > CPT/HCPCS Codes > Modifiers**.
- Click **New**.

Adding a New Modifier

- Enter a 2 digit modifier code in the Mod Code field.

- Enter the modifier description in Mod Desc.

RVU % Reduction/Increase: These fields are not mandatory. The Total/Work RVU will only be reduced or increased by the percent entered here when running the RVU Report.

- Click the checkmark to save the Modifier.

Note: The system will bring you back to a blank screen in the event you need to add another Modifier. Click the **X** to exit the screen.
