


HCC CODING

Hierarchical Condition Categories are groups of diagnosis codes used to assess and predict overall risk of individual patients enrolled in Medicare Advantage plans.

Dx Selection Screen


HCC codes will display with a yellow highlight in the Selected Dx's box regardless of whether they have been selected in the current year.

NOTE: Codes highlighted in blue indicate they are on the patient's problem list.

Dx History Screen

When enabled, medent checks the Dx History and Problem List for each patient and highlights all HCC codes from HCC categories that have not been selected since January 1.



Highlight HCC Codes

When selected, HCC codes will highlight in yellow amongst the patient's past diagnoses/problems, sorted newest to oldest. This defaults on.

2

Highlight HCC Codes and show them at the top

When selected, HCC codes will highlight in yellow at the top of the patient's diagnoses for Dx History and Problem List views. HCC codes in other areas will display highlighted in their sorted order.

3

Don't Highlight HCC codes

When selected, this option will disable HCC highlighting.
