


So you need to set up your screen preferences in medent.

What's next?

medent screen settings can be set up for a PC, laptop, device and Windows User.

This allows customization of medent's display, monitor display, color or color-blind configuration.



PC/Display Settings

- Click the main menu button in the top right corner of the screen > **Settings** > **My Preferences** > **PC/Display Settings**.

Display

Color Scheme Charcoal

Font Size Large

Sidebar Font Default

Start Sessions At Main Menu

- Color Scheme:** Choose a color for medent screens. This is helpful for working under florescent lighting.
- Font Size:** Select the font size. Note: In Chart Central, anything greater than large may create display issues.
- Start Sessions At:** Select if sessions should open at the Main Menu, Chart Central or Message Central.

Additional Options

- Other Options > Color Blind Configuration:** Colors used in medent are changed to a recognizable shade.
- Other Options > Show Notification Animation:** Defaulted on, but may be turned off if too distracting for staff.

Notification Animation alerts display in the main menu button area. Users can also customize these under Medical Records > Preferences > My Preferences > My Menu Notifications.

medent Screen Settings

- Check whether you'd like to enable or disable certain features in medent.

Enable Dragon Speech Recognition For This Pc

Use Shorthand (Shft-Space Override)

Disable Ctrl+A for selecting all items

Skip Font Resize Check

Enable Horizontal Touch Gestures

Enable Touch Mode

Enable sound

Apply settings to this Windows user only

- These settings may be applied to the Windows user.

Providers typically enable Dragon, Shorthand, Sound and Touch.

- After making changes, click Close.
